*Camping with hookups – the \$30 fee includes the \$10.00 Day Riding Fee per horse (total of \$30). Primitive Camping – add \$5 per day to the \$10 fee for the Day Riding Fee per horse (total of \$15). Those who just come out to ride for the day but do not camp out will be required to pay \$10 total.

Driving Directions:

From Levasy, MO – take 24 Highway East 14 miles to through Lexington. Turn **LEFT** onto Highway 224 and almost immediately turn **RIGHT** onto GOODLOE ORCHARD RD. Follow Goodloe Orchard Rd. around a corner to right to the end of the road (approx. 1.6 miles) where you will see a sign for the Ranch.

From Oak Grove, MO – take I-70 East to Exit No. 41 (Highway O). Turn **LEFT** (North) and go approximately 10 miles (Highway O merges into Highway 13 when you get into Lexington). Stay on Highway 13 through Lexington approximately 0.8 miles and turn **RIGHT** to merge onto 24 Highway East. Take 24 Highway East approximately 2.6 miles and turn **LEFT** onto MO-224 and almost immediately turn **RIGHT** onto GOODLOE ORCHARD RD. Follow Goodloe Orchard Rd. around a corner to right to the end of the road (approx. 1.6 miles) where you will see a sign for the Ranch.
